## ACTIVITIES

Meet a guide in the courtyard for the activity of your choice. Activities have capacity limits and are first-come, first-served. We may not offer every activity during every time slot.

### **Activity Session 1 Options**

**Arbor Climb\*** - Climb 30 foot pines via rock climbing holds. Includes a ride in a truck and a  $\sim 1/2$  mile hike.

Archery - Shoot targets with bows & arrows.

**Archery Tag -** A group game where you fire foam tipped arrows at opposing teams.

BB Guns- Shoot BB Guns in our unique target range.

Drift Ball - Play handball while riding drift trikes on our basketball court.

**Mountain Bikes** -Either ride on your own or join a guided ride on a beginner's level trail. *Mountain bikes can also be checked at other points of the day.* 

**Mountain Scooters** - Take a truck to the top of the lookout and ride down the trail on a mountain scooter.

Paddle Boards - Glide across the water of Glorieta's lake.

RC Cars - Remote control cars on a dirt race track.

#### **Activity Session 2 Options**

Flylines\* - Zipline off the top of Holcomb Auditorium.

Holcomb Rappel\* - Rappel down the side of Holcomb Auditorium.

Snow Tube^ - Ride in a tube down our snowless tubing hill.

**Via Ferrata\*** - Mountaineering meets obstacle coarse in this horizontal climbing path.

**Zip Drop\*** - A zip line with special auto belays that let you drift to the ground like a parachuter coming in for a landing.

#### Sometimes Offered During Activity Session 2

**Mountain Scooters** - Offered in some afternoons of our highest-attendance sessions. Take a truck to the top of the lookout and ride down the trail on a mountain scooter.

**Hide & Seek** - Offered once a week as scheduling allows. More info will be announced at camp. Ride out to a boulder field for some classic fun.

**Holcomb Grotto** - Offered if conference groups are not making use of this space. An indoor bouldering area with fun neon vibes.

### What to Bring/Wear:

- Water
- Sunglasses / Sunscreen / Bugspray
- Rain Jacket
- Closed-toe athletic shoes and socks
- Medium to long length shorts or pants for harnessed activities



- **1.** Where can I get medical assistance? Guides will have basic first aid supplies, and we'll also have supplies in the Gear Den next to Aspen Cafe. For serious medical assistance, please take your family member to a medical center in Santa Fe or call 911, and then alert a Family Camp staffer.
- **2. I need assistance but can't find a staff member. What should I do?** Text the Family Camp number you received a message from at check-in.
- **3.** It's activity time but some of my family wants to nap. Can the rest of us still participate? Absolutely! Activities aren't mandatory (nor is anything at Family Camp, for that matter). Just meet your guide at the designated time with however many family members want to participate!
- **4. When else can I go to the lake?** Most days the lake will be open from 3-5pm. This time is primarily for conference guests but families are usually welcome as well. Check in with your guide to make sure this is an option for the particular day you'd like to go.
- **5. What activities are available during Night Fun?** We'll be opening the flylines, zip drop or snow tube hill, and we'll announce which one during the day.
- **6.** I have to run to the hotel room but my kids are playing in the courtyard. Can I leave them there for a couple minutes? Yes, but please let a family friend or staffer know before you go.
- 7. One of my younger kids is too old for KidTribe but doesn't want to participate in an activity. Can he or she go to KidTribe for a short time? KidTribe is for 5 and under, but if your child can play well with younger kids and if KidTribe has room that day, yes!

- **8.** I have food allergies. How can I find the ingredients in the meals? Ask the kitchen staff or your guide.
- **9.** When are the Tea and Craft Rooms Open and can I send my kids to the Tea and Craft Rooms unattended? They are open all day long and no, for safety reasons, they should be accompanied by an adult.
- **10.** Where can I do laundry? At the washateria (see our map/scan the QR code on the front cover of this!) **Do I need to bring my own detergent/softener?** Yes. **Is it free to use?** Yes! No need to bring quarters.
- **11.** I see people using the Prayer Room. What's this for? This room is the designated space for times of prayer and counsel with the Host Family. You can sign up for a time on the clipboard in the Worship Room. Outside of those times, the Prayer Room is a space to come be quiet with the Lord.
- **12. Should I tip my guide(s)?** This is entirely up to you. Tips are not expected nor are they the norm. If you'd like to tip, know that it will be greatly appreciated and that monetary tips will go towards an end of the year team celebration. Physical gifts can be kept personally by your guide(s).
- **13.** How can I give back to Glorieta? Become a part of Aspen Club! More info can be found at glorieta.org/donate/.
- **14.** Where can I check out putters, golf balls, backpacks, hammocks, and other fun things? At the Gear Den next to Aspen Cafe! Pop in any time the door is open to see what's available. Items can be checked out either for the day or the whole session.
- **15. When can I check out a Mountain Bike?** Usually during free time and only with an adult. A staff member will be at the Bike Garage to give you further instructions.
